Privacy assured

Almost all professional websites, including ours, use cookies. Cookies are tiny files that are downloaded and stored on your computer, in order to improve your experience.

A cookie does not give us access to your computer or any information about you, however we are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

About cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you or your computer agrees, the file is added and the cookie helps us analyse website traffic and lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

There are two main kinds of cookies: "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies. Session cookies only last for the duration of users using the website and are deleted from your computer when you close your browser, whereas persistent cookies outlast user sessions and remain stored on your computer until deleted, or until they reach their expiry date.

Cookies on our website

KAT Communications Ltd use both session cookies and persistent cookies on our websites. Our cookies are used to recognise your computer when you visit one of our websites.

KAT Communications Ltd websites may offer customer log in areas, document download, catalogue, live chat, certificate, newsletter or email subscription services and cookies may be used to remember if you are already registered and whether to show certain notifications which might only be valid to subscribed or unsubscribed users.

Cookies in our email communications

KAT Communications Ltd also use cookies in our email communications.

The cookies in our emails track whether the email has been opened or whether the recipient has used any website links provided in the email communication. This allows us to monitor and improve our email communications and website in the interest of providing a better service to our users.

Third party cookies

In some special cases KAT Communications Ltd also use cookies provided by trusted third parties.

Third party analytics are used to track and measure usage of this site so that we can continue to produce engaging content. These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on one of our websites or pages you visit to help us to understand how we can improve our services for you.

KAT Communications Ltd also use social media buttons and/or plugins on this site that allow you to connect with your social network in various ways. For these to work, social media sites including Facebook and Google+ will set cookies through our site which may be used to enhance your profile on their site or contribute to the data they hold for various purposes outlined in their respective privacy policies.

Google Analytics

KAT Communications Ltd also use cookies to help us improve our website's usability and for marketing purposes. We may also use cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about webpage traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. KAT Communications Ltd only use this information for statistical purposes.
